## Booking and Times

**Standard Arrival times** – you can drop your children off from 9am – 9.15am

**Collection times** – children can be collected at 3.30pm

**St Marys, Moss Side** – 10am – 2pm

**Wrap around care (booked online separate to main booking)** not available at all venues

Early drop off from 8am – 8.55am = £3.50

Stay and Play from 3.30pm – 5pm = £4.50

## Children's Arrival

All children will be dropped off by parents / carers at the designated point marked out on the map (next pages). Nobody other than children and PSCL may pass this point. This will ensure nobody other than children and PSCL staff are able to enter the school building.

## Collecting Children

At their designated collection time the children will line up. Parents and carers will arrive at the collection point (same as drop off point) and meet the course manager.

The Course Manager will call each child's name who will meet their parent / carer at the collection point.

## Alternative drop off and collection times

If you need to drop off late or collect early please arrange this with the course manager.

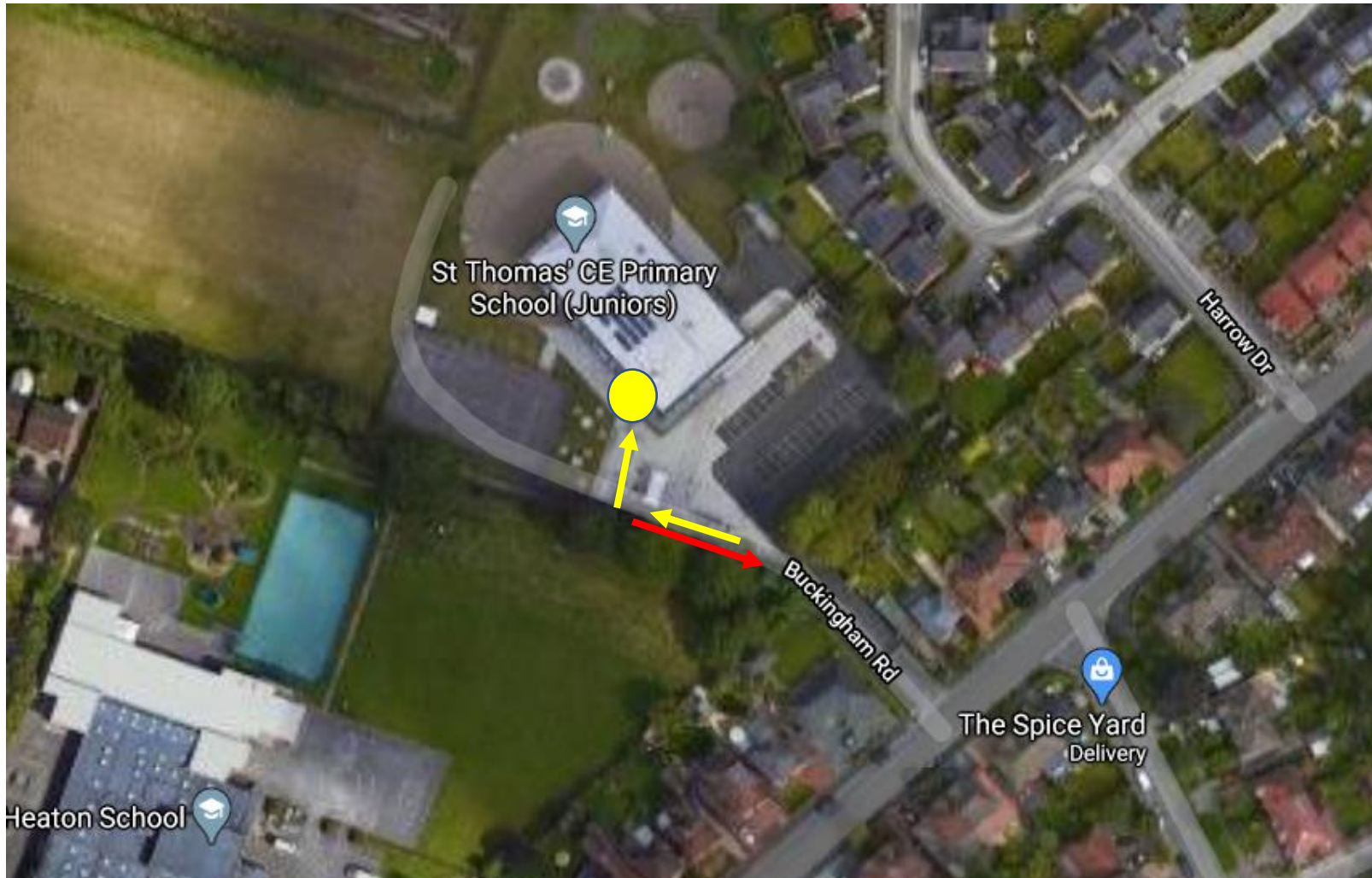

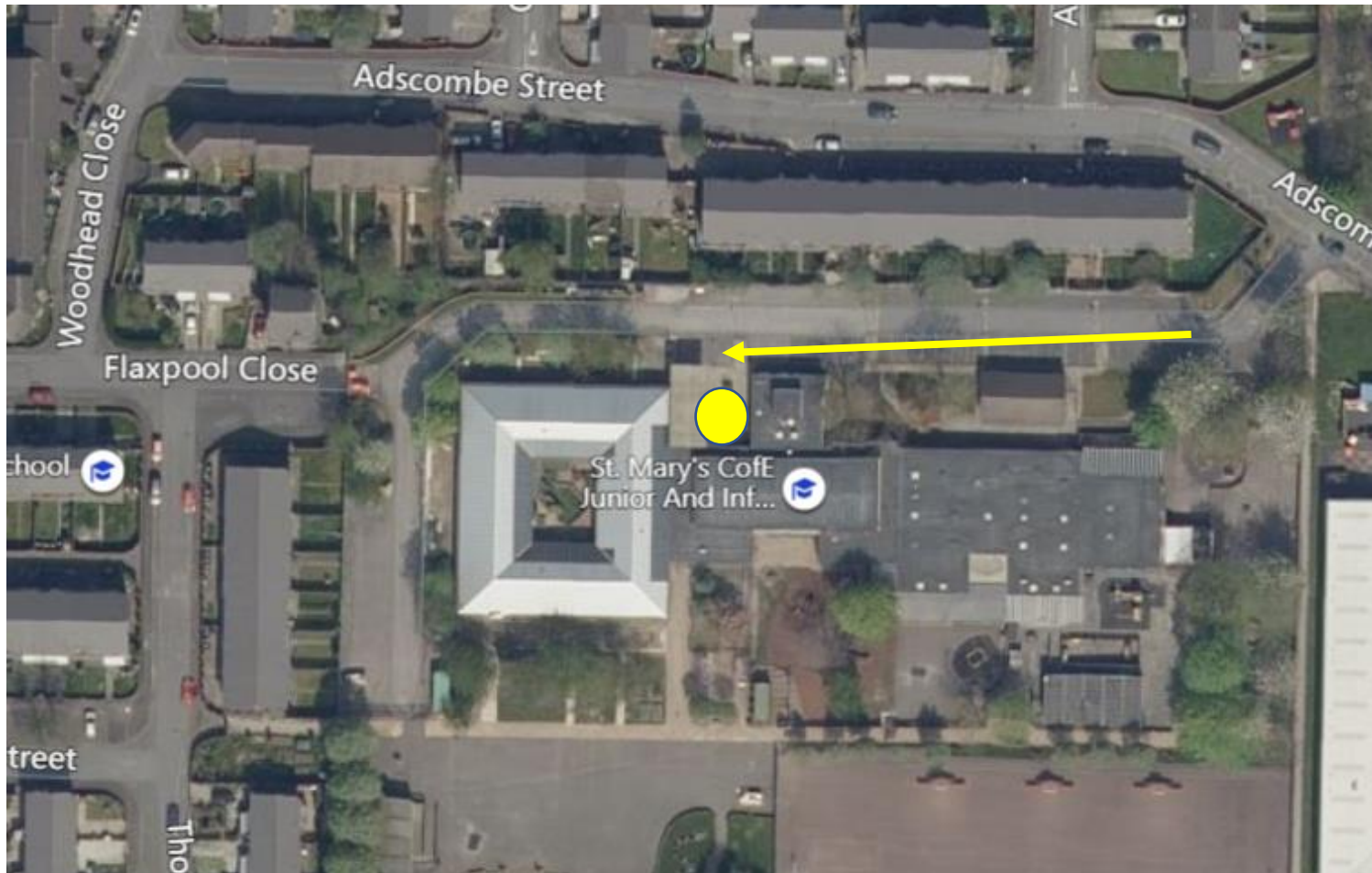

## Sun cream

Our coaches do not have any sun cream with them that they can share with your child.

Put sun cream on your child before arrival, don't forget their ears, back of the neck and legs as well as their face and arms.

Send a sun cream in your child's bag with their name on the bottle.

Our coaches are not allowed to put sun cream on the children. Your child will be expected to put their own sun cream on.

## Frequently Asked Questions

### **1. How do I know my child will be safe at the Holiday Courses?**

Our existing policies and procedures are updated and reviewed regularly. PSCL team members will complete all necessary training prior to the school holidays and current government guidelines will be adhered to.

Parents / Guardians can leave their children safe in the knowledge that PSCL Holiday Courses are a registered Ofsted provider. All of our settings are on the Voluntary part of the childcare register.

### **2. Can my children switch groups?**

If the holiday courses week hasn't started and there is capacity, we will be able to let you switch groups. However, we expect holiday courses to be at full capacity and if this is the case we may not be able to allow your child to switch groups. If you would like your child to be with a friend you will need to liaise with them directly to try and ensure that your children are in the same group because we cannot share the booking details of other customers with you.

### **3. My child has medication that is kept in school can they access it?**

No, we don't have access to any medication that is kept at your child's school.

Please bring any inhalers, epi pens etc with you and pass them over to the course manager upon arrival. The course manager will ask you to complete a medicines form and then will store the medication appropriately.

## Frequently Asked Questions

### **4. How will the sign in/out process work?**

The course manager will sign your child in and out electronically on their tablets that have provided by PSCL. Registration and sign-out at each venue will be completed at a clear drop off point which we only allow children beyond. There will be clear signs and markers to indicate where to drop off and collect your children. We ask that nobody other than the PSCL coaches and the children go past this point.

### **5. What does my child need to wear and bring?**

Our activities will be taking place outdoors unless the weather decides otherwise. Your child should wear / bring to wear:

Tracksuit, T shirt, shorts, trainers, rain-coat, healthy packed lunch, healthy snacks, plenty of still drink and / or a bottle that can be refilled, their manners and a smile!!

For this coming course we also recommend a warm outdoor coat, hats and gloves.

If they are in the football group they will need in addition to the above:  
Football boots, Shin pads, Trainers (for indoor activities)

## Frequently Asked Questions

### 5. Continued

Please do not bring:

Tablets, phones, electronic devices, nuts or food with nuts in, fizzy drinks, food to share, food that needs heating up



Our courses are **NUT FREE!!!** We may have children attending our courses who have severe nut allergies, for this reason we ask that children do not bring nuts or food with nuts with them to our courses.

### 6. What will happen if I arrive at the wrong time to collect my child?

If you know you are going to be late, please let the course manager know. The course managers phone number will be clearly visible when you arrive at the course on the first morning.

### **7. Will there be an end of week presentation?**

We love to recognise excellent effort and achievement at our holiday courses. There will be a presentation at the end of each week, they will be conducted by the groups lead coach in their own classroom or hall.

Unfortunately we won't be able to allow parents/carers to watch the presentations. Where possible we will take photographs and publish the winners on our social media pages along with a paragraph of why they deserve their accolades.
